## Parents, Guardians, and Students

Welcome Back Eagles! We are excited to return to what we hope will be a normal school year for our students, parents, school, and community. Last year was an unprecedented year with so many unexpected hardships, but we made it through together.

As we return this semester, I want to update everyone on our arrival and departure procedures. **At this time**, masks are optional.


### Arrival

- Homeroom/class will begin at 7:45.
- Buses and cars may arrive on campus at 7:25. Buses will not be allowed to unload and car riders will not be allowed to be on campus prior to 7:25.
- PreK-4 will report directly to class.
- 5-8 will report to the lunchroom and remain until the homeroom bell and teachers will escort to homeroom.
- 9-12 eat breakfast upon arrival and go directly to the homeroom.

### Departure

- **Pre-K** will dismiss through the front of the gym, cars will enter the southmost gate and exit the next gate at 2:30. Only Pre-K may enter these gates prior to 2:30.
- **K-12** car riders will be dismissed prior to bus riders by announcement. Please do not enter the parking lot prior to 2:20 and enter through the middle gate and exit out the north end. We will have markers to help identify these.
- Bell will ring at 2:45 dismissing bus riders. No students are allowed on campus outside of school hours unless with a certified staff member for a school activity (practice etc).

As we return to what we hope is a normal school year, all these procedures are to ensure your child's safety and well-being. We expect car rider lines to be long, especially the first week of school, and with a Pre-K being added, we have had to modify afternoon dismissal. Please be aware of children and be patient with us as we ensure they get safely to their vehicle. Looking forward to a great school year,
